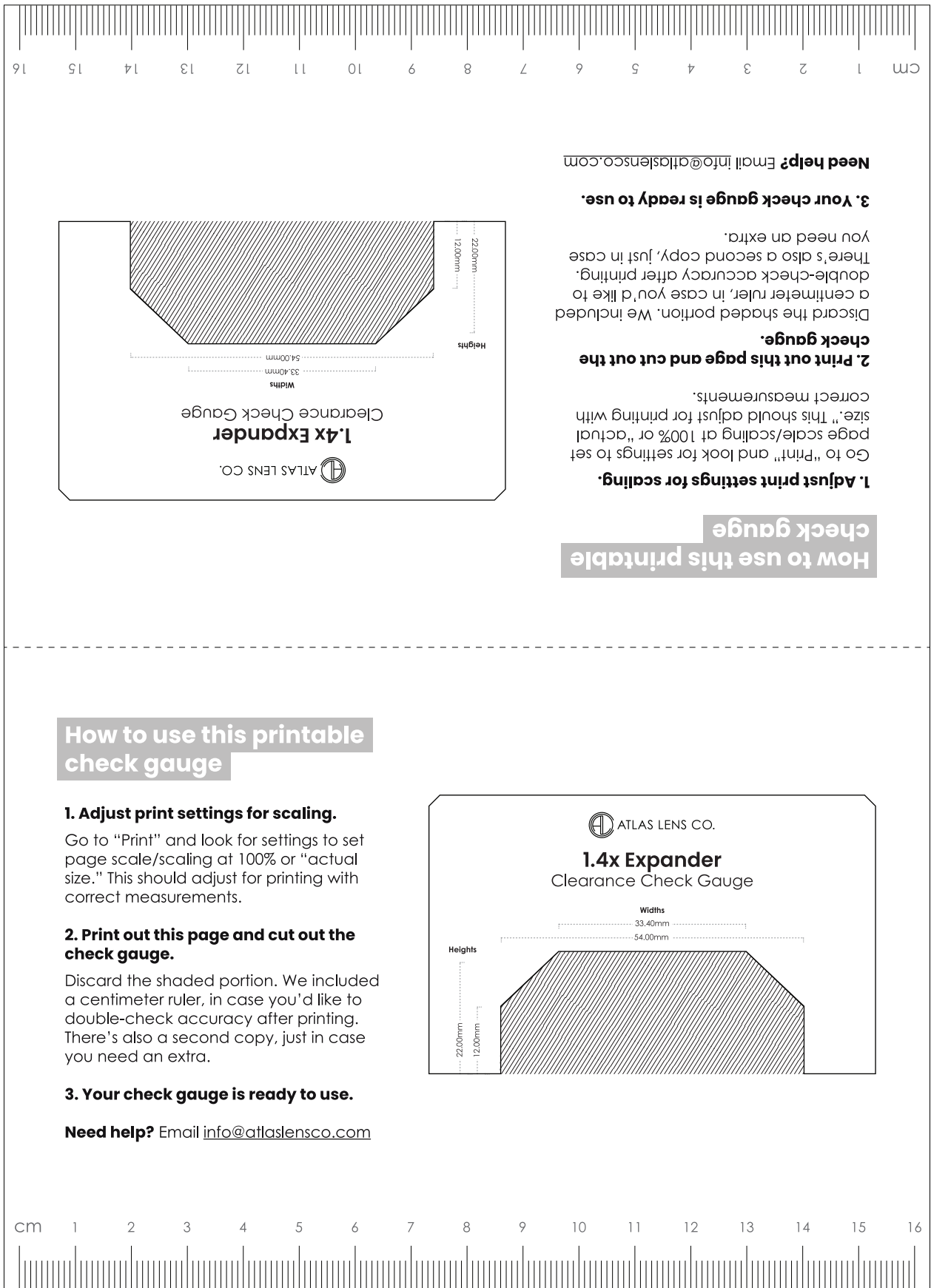




How to use this printable check gauge

- 1. Adjust print settings for scaling.**
Go to "Print" and look for settings to set page scale/scaling at 100% or "actual size." This should adjust for printing with correct measurements.
- 2. Print out this page and cut out the check gauge.**
Discard the shaded portion. We included a centimeter ruler, in case you'd like to double-check accuracy after printing. There's also a second copy, just in case you need an extra.
- 3. Your check gauge is ready to use.**
