## Genie Mini

An extremely easy-to-use device for creating smooth panning motion time-lapse or real-time video. Wirelessly connect to the Genie Mini using the Syrp Genie App for quick setup and simple motion control.

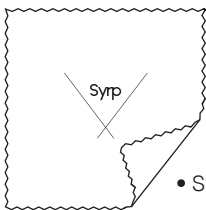

## Whats in the Box

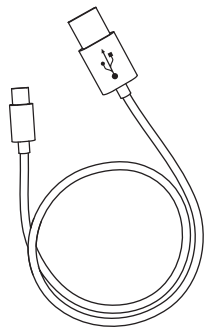
- Genie Mini



- 1/4" to 3/8" Thread adapter (screwed into the base)



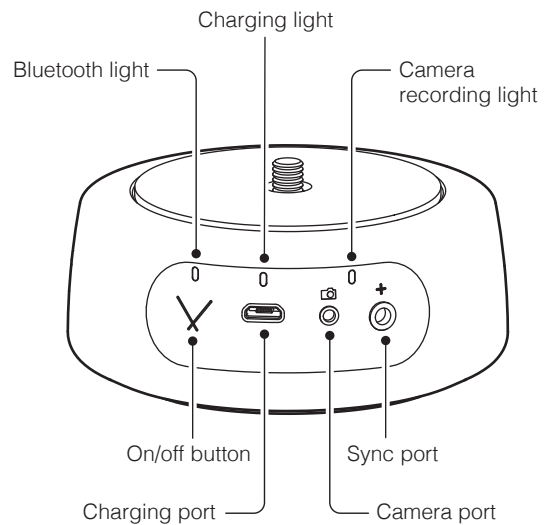
- Syrp Micro Fiber cloth



- USB charging cable

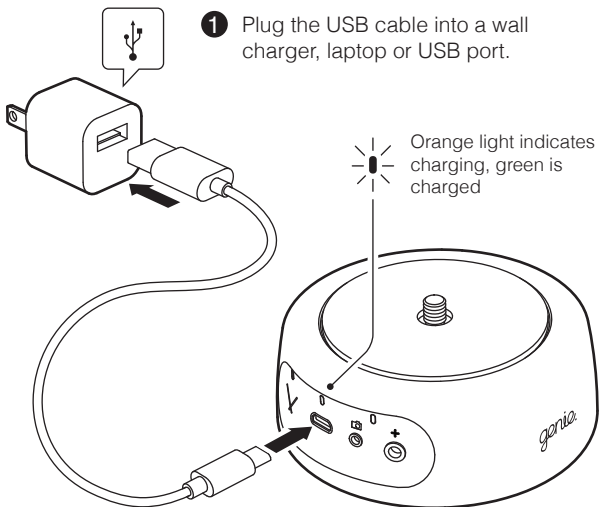

## Charging



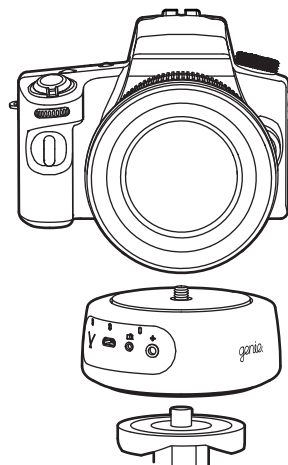
- 1 Plug the USB cable into a wall charger, laptop or USB port.

- 2 Plug the Micro-USB plug into the Genie Mini charging port.

## Mount the Genie Mini

- 1 Screw the Genie Mini to a tripod head or tripod legs. The thread adapter in the base can be used for smaller threads.
- 2 Screw your camera to the top of the Genie Mini.



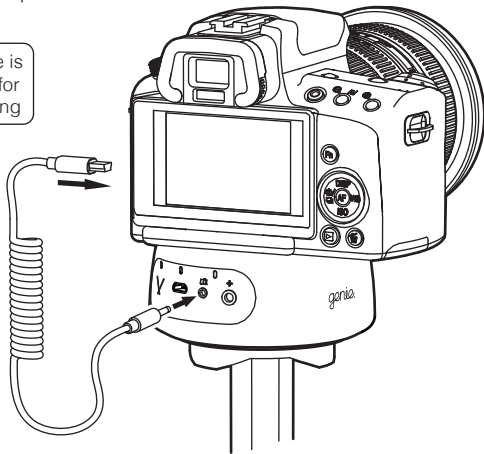
Try a ballhead between the camera & Genie Mini to easily frame your shots

### Link Cable

- 1 Plug the 2.5mm end into the camera port on the Genie Mini marked with a green camera icon.
- 2 Plug the other end into the remote port on your camera. Consult your camera manual to find the correct port.

The link cable is not required for video recording

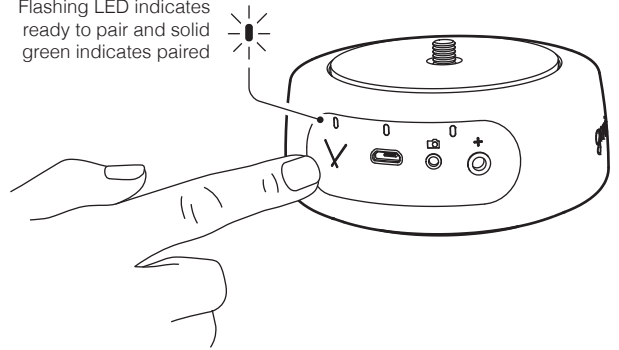

### Genie Mini Connect

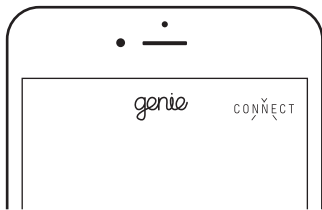
- 1 Turn bluetooth ON in the settings menu on your device.
- 2 Download the Syrp Genie App and open.
- 3 Press the Syrp cross on the Genie Mini once to turn it on. (Don't hold the Syrp button down)

Flashing LED indicates ready to pair and solid green indicates paired

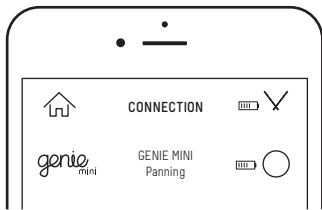

### App Connect

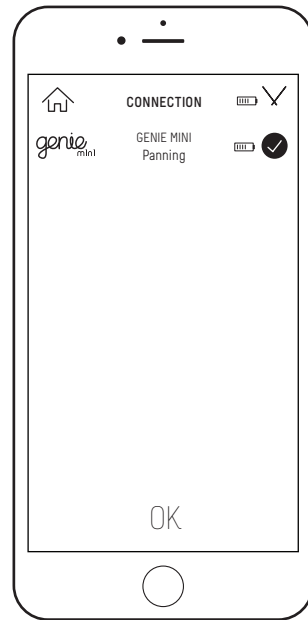


- 1 Tap the CONNECT icon

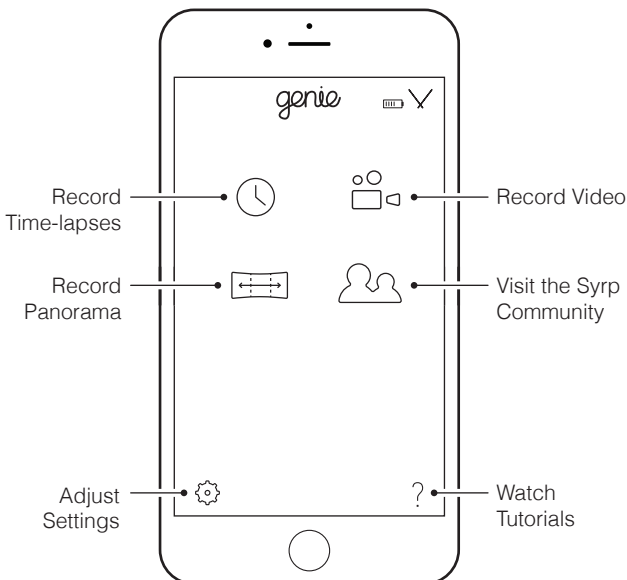


- 3 Tick confirms connection

### Genie Mini Quick Tips

- Always set your camera and lens to manual focus (MF), if set to Auto Focus (AF) the camera can mis fire leading to missed frames.
- Turn image review OFF on your camera. On some cameras image review can cause missed frames in your time-lapse.
- Once you begin a recording you can leave the App and disconnect, your move will continue to run as normal.
- Press the Syrp button once to turn the Genie Mini on/off. Holding the Syrp button down for longer forces a hardware / firmware reset on the Genie Mini.
- To turn the Genie Mini off you must first disconnect in the connection window on the Syrp Genie App before pressing the Syrp button once.

### Firmware Tips

The App will automatically alert you if a new firmware update is available and will be installed from within the App. If you have trouble updating the Firmware try these tips:

- Try to update on a different device, if it works you can go back to using your original device.
- Turn WIFI off on your device.
- Do not connect to other bluetooth devices while updating, it's best to turn off other nearby bluetooth devices completely, or the update may fail.
- Try the update from a different location, in some situations unknown interference can cause a failed update.
- If the update fails with a flashing red LED, hold the Syrp button down for 10 sec to reset the Genie Mini. Then quit and reopen the App and reconnect your Genie Mini.
